

We recently checked in with Jay Glascock, who served as the PR Chair and Webmaster from 1999 to 2003. He also served on the Assisted Readiness, Young Members, Awards, and many other committees during his tenure with SAME Kittyhawk. While Jay was at WPAFB he served as the Headquarters AFMC Staff Civil Engineer and Executive Officer to the Command Civil Engineer.

Mr. Glascock has been very busy since leaving WPAFB and SAME Kittyhawk. He graduated from Air University, Air Command and Staff College, was a Commander with the Civil Engineer Squadron of the United States Air Force and a Joint Staff Engineer with the Joint Chiefs of Staff.

In this role he develops policies and procedures governing the Department's construction and environmental project management efforts. He has also served as a project engineer, planner, programmer, designer, and manager for major construction, alteration, and repair projects at Air Force bases in the United States, Republic of South Korea, Jordan, and Ascension Island.

He attended the United States Air Force Academy to earn his BS in General Engineering and the University of New Mexico for his Bachelors and Masters of Science in Civil Engineering with emphasis in Construction Management.

Some of Mr. Glascock's fondest SAME Kittyhawk memories were judging at the West District Science Fairs at Wright State University with John Koerner and Gary Tucker and working with Dr. Goltz to award scholarships and nominations to the U.S. Air Force Academy Construction Camp to impressive high school students.
