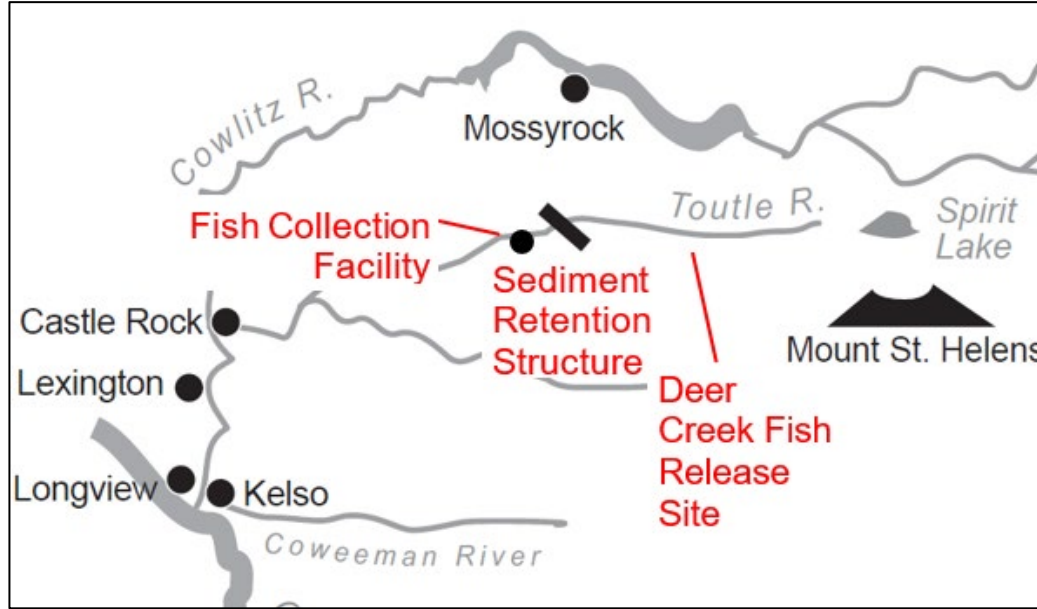

JOHN DAY TURBINE REPLACEMENT AND GENERATOR REHABILITATION (TRGR)



- Replacement of up to 16 turbines at John Day Dam
- Supply with Install contract will include:
 - design of fixed and adjustable blade turbines,
 - manufacture,
 - delivery, and
 - Installation,
 - as well as generator rewinds
- Order of magnitude approximately >\$1B
- Scheduled to advertise Q1FY25
- +20-year period of performance through 2051

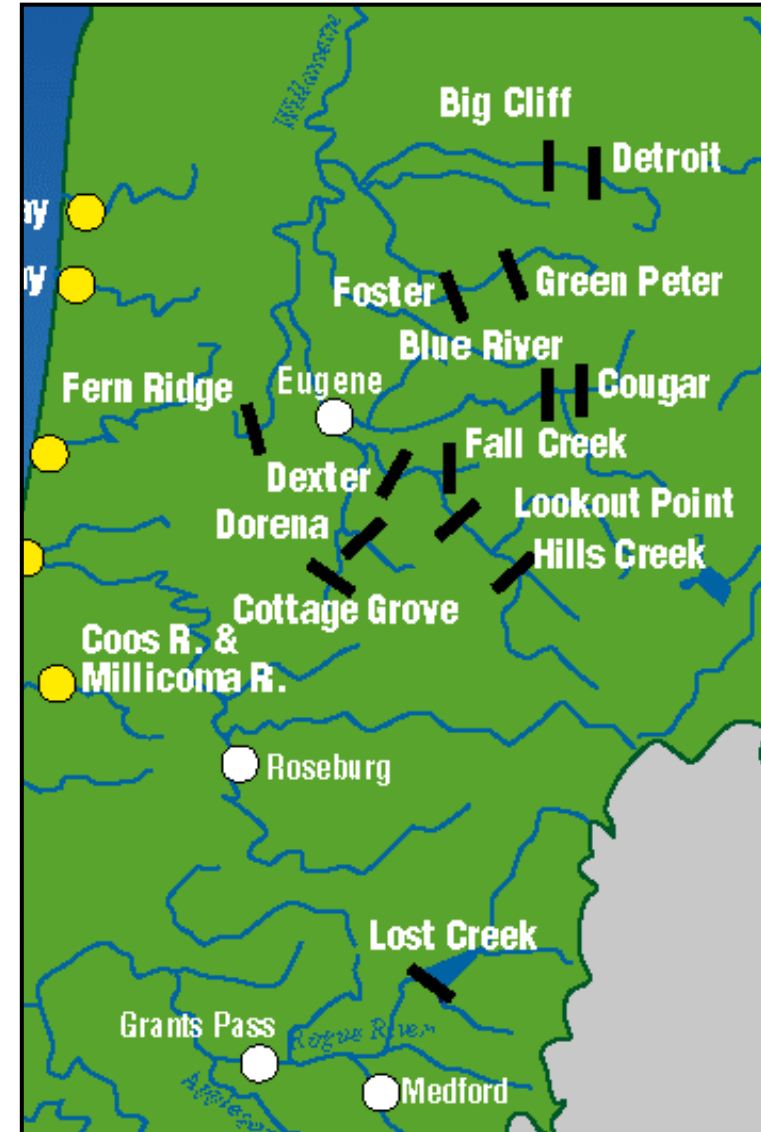

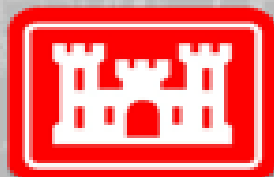
