By adopting Lean and Lean Construction principles and concepts, she is also committed to create a culture of continuous improvement focusing on maximizing the value for our customers, improving quality outcomes, while reducing non-value-added activities. She was instrumental in implementing an employee engagement program in the department which received Authority-wide recognition and still exists today. Prior to joining Massport, she held several positions at the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance (DCAMM) for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Dr. Burdi is a member of the CMAA National Board of Directors, the Chair of the CMAA (Construction Management Association of America) Emerging Technologies Committee. In October 2015, she received the CMAA National Award in New Technologies techniques in CM for advancing the use of valuable new technologies in construction management. Dr. Burdi earned her CCM (certified construction manager) in 2019.

Moreover, she is an active member of the BSA (Boston Society of Architects) BIM Roundtable, the Lean Construction Institute New England Community of Practice, the AIA TAP (Technology in Architectural Practice), and AGC (Association of General Contractors) of America.

She received her Doctorate from Harvard Graduate School of Design. Previously, she was a SPURS Fellow (Special Program in Urban and Regional Studies) at MIT and she holds a Master's Degree from the Istituto Universitario di Architettura di Venezia (IUAV) in Venice Italy.

	SAME Boston Post Scholarship Endowments History

In 1998, upon the 75th birthday of the Boston Post of the Society of American Military Engineers (SAME), a "senior" group of longtime members were convened to author the history of the Post. The gentlemen were Leo McGrath, Chan Rogers, Joe Ignazio, Ed Condon, George Bottger, S. Peter Volpe and myself, Joe Bocchino. The Post used to call the US Army Corps of Engineers New England Division (it was an "Operating Division" back then reporting directly to HQ in Washington, DC) our home. This convention of "old-timers" was probably one of the last things we did at the old Murphy Army Hospital on Trapelo Road in Waltham.

The scholarship history for the Post begins in 1954. The first donation and award was for \$250. Unfortunately, this writer does not have the records at hand as to who won the award and what school they were attending ... or planning to attend. At the onset, the scholarships were made to High School seniors – until the task got too big to handle.

Those early awards grew to \$500 and Northeastern's Student Chapter of SAME captured the 1955 "Outstanding Student Chapter Award."

The infamous annual "Program Book" which is almost a mirror of today's versions was born in 1956. The penultimate Post event was dubbed "The Annual Spring Meeting" and the proceeds from the book were directed to a devoted scholarship fund. In 1957, the Boston Post was crowned SAME's Most Outstanding Post." Essayons.

By the middle "sixties," the scholarship program became the driving force for the Post. Six scholarships totaling \$3000 were awarded in 1966; and, that was huge money in 1966.

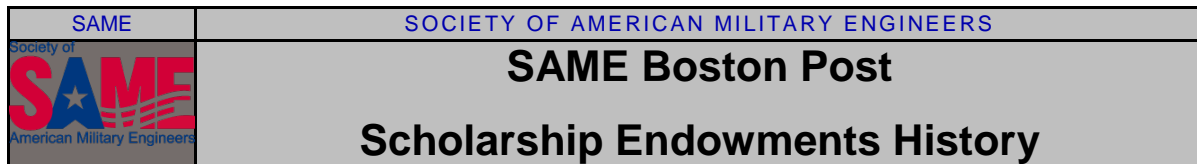
1970 saw \$5000 in scholarships.

1980 recorded \$8000 to four students. In 1981, over 100 High School students were considered. In 1982, the Post reverted to dealing with just the "local" engineering colleges and universities. The Post experienced its ups and downs due to the decreasing military presence in the area, but the glue for the Post was and still is our scholarship program. 1989 saw \$15,000 awarded to eight students.

Perspective to our 21st century scholarships yields sincere appreciation for the impact these scholarships must have had on their recipients' futures. From the late 1950's through to 1984, substantial monies were accrued to what became known as the "Permanent Scholarship Fund." In that 1984 year, the Post amended our ByLaws to allow for matching funds to any donor who endowed a scholarship.

And the endowments were christened. The venerable S. Peter Volpe, Past Post President (Volpe Construction and brother of past Massachusetts Governor, John Volpe, and Past Post President Peter Volpe) and COL Thomas H. O'Connor, USA ret. (O'Connor Construction) stepped up to the plate and endowed scholarships to their respective alma maters: Merrimack College and MIT. May 1985 saw their first awards.

1989 saw two additional endowments. Nick Avtges from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers came forward and endowed a scholarship at Tufts University in the name of his son Michael who passed from cancer while at Tufts. And the storied company of Metcalf & Eddy (now embedded within AECOM) endowed a



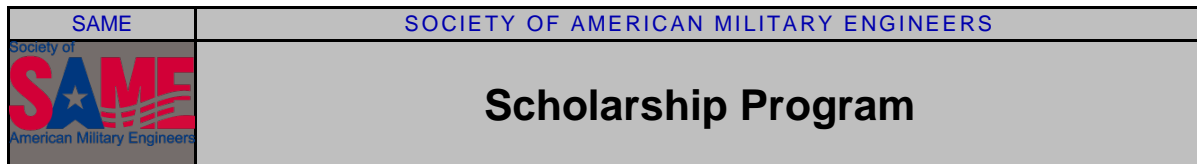
scholarship at the equally storied Norwich University. By 1990, the Post Scholarship program accounted for over a quarter of a million dollars! Many more endowments followed.

The decade of the 1990's saw:

- The Bob Fortune scholarship at Wentworth. Bob was a long-time member who passed before his time. The endowment is represented on the Scholarship Committee by his brother John.
- George Bottger and Ed Greco, pals and both Past Post Presidents, combined forces and endowed a scholarship at Northeastern.
- Chan Lin, now represented by son Michael on the Post Scholarship Committee, endowed another scholarship at Northeastern.
- The Boston Society of Civil Engineers saw the opportunity to do a good deed. They had long been a sister society of SAME and chose to honor Bert Berger at Northeastern.
- SEA Consultants memorialized its founder Arnold Goldstein at Northeastern
- And the world-famous Tuskegee Airmen, thanks to Past Post President Jack Bryant – a member of the illustrious unit, local New England chapter set-up a “very large” endowment at Wentworth. Jack’s son Jeff is on the Scholarship Committee.

The 21st century saw even more endowments. The Bocchino Scholarship was established at Tufts University. Weston Solutions set up an endowment at UNH. Watermark jumped in with its own endowment at UMass. Don Martin, of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and virtual anchor of the Post for many years was honored when he passed with a scholarship in his name at UMass.

Today we look at the 67-year history of the SAME Boston Post Scholarship Program with pride. We have done very much for our industry, our profession’s future, and our great Nation. Total awards are in the millions of dollars. And we look forward to doing even more as we embark upon our next century as a professional engineering and science society.



The Scholarship Committee would like to thank all the donors, subscribers and friends who helped to make the 61st Annual Spring Meeting a great success. This year, the Boston Post is proud to grant \$59,000 in scholarships to thirteen deserving engineering and science undergraduates. Our appreciation for your kind generosity cannot be overstated or measured.

The Boston Post worked with nine universities and colleges having accredited engineering and science programs. Out of the many deserving students who applied for these scholarships, thirteen were selected and were awarded scholarships in April 2021, and all of which will be recognized tonight. The criteria for a Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) Scholarship embraces academic and personal achievements coupled with financial need and an interest in pursuing an education in engineering, environmental sciences or construction related fields. Our focus is to support the development of future engineers and scientists to serve and strengthen our Nation.

The Boston Post has been blessed with significant endowments. The generous donors of these endowments serve as the core strength of our program.
