Indian Affairs

Maintain government-to-government relationships with Indian tribes and facilitate support for tribal people and tribal governments.

Promote safe and quality living environments, strong communities, self sufficiency and individual rights, while enhancing protection of the lives, prosperity and well being of American Indians and Alaska Natives.

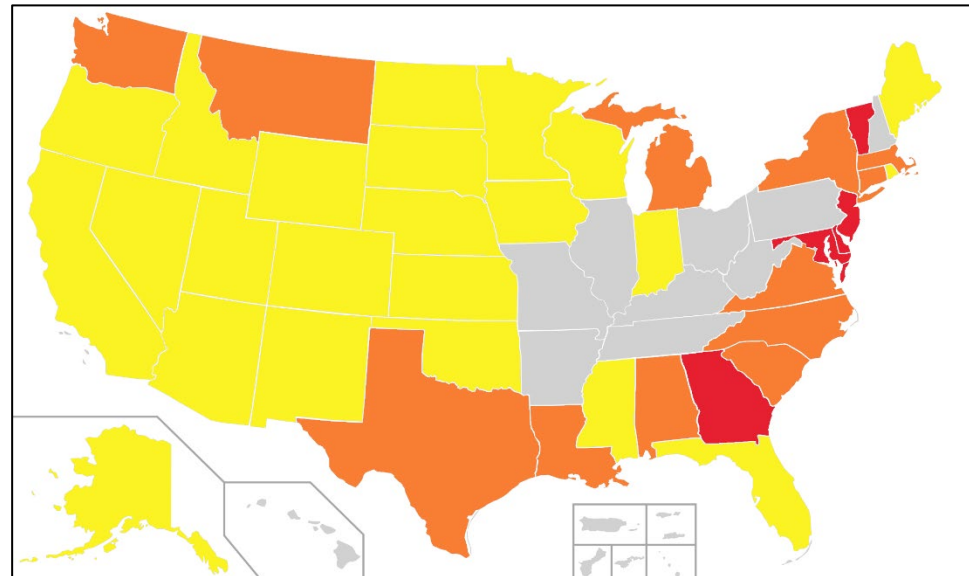


Indian Affairs

We provide services directly or through contracts, grants, or compacts to 574 Federally recognized tribes with a service population of approximately 2.5 million American Indian and Alaska Natives.

IA is comprised of:

- The Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs (AS-IA)
- Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA)
- Bureau of Indian Education (BIE)
- Bureau of Trust Fund Administration (BTFA)

The Buy Indian Act at IA

The Buy Indian Act of 1910 provides the authority to set-aside federal procurement contracts for Indian-owned and controlled businesses.

Use of this authority is mandatory for Indian Affairs and Dept of Health and Human Services, Indian Health Services

IA procurements, regardless of dollar value, must be set aside for Indian businesses to the maximum extent practicable



The Buy Indian Act at DOI

In May 2022, the DOI Acquisition Regulations were revised:

A. Eliminated the restriction on Indian Economic Enterprises (IEE) from competing on "covered" construction contracts issued under the Buy Indian Act.

B. Expanded IEEs' ability to subcontract work subject to the Buy Indian Act consistent with other government socio-economic set-aside programs.

C. Gave greater preference to IEEs in the set-aside decision process.



The Buy Indian Act at DOI

In December 2022 DOI Policy was revised:

All DOI bureaus and offices have the authority to procure supplies, services, architect, and engineering (A&E) services, or construction while giving preference to Indian Economic Enterprises under authority of the Buy Indian Act

Established Indian Small Business Economic Enterprise (ISBEE) goals:

The Fiscal Year 2023 ISBEE goals for non-Indian Affairs Bureaus: 10% for prime awards and 3% for subcontract awards



Impact on Construction Contracts

- The "covered" construction language in the regulation is no longer required by law. DOI removed all references to "covered" construction throughout the regulation.
- **All construction contracts may now be set-aside to IEEs.**

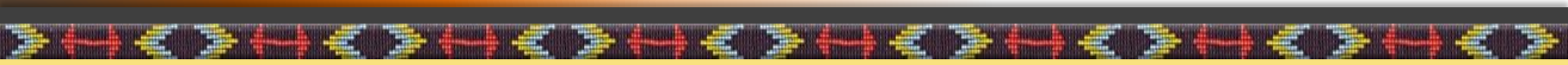

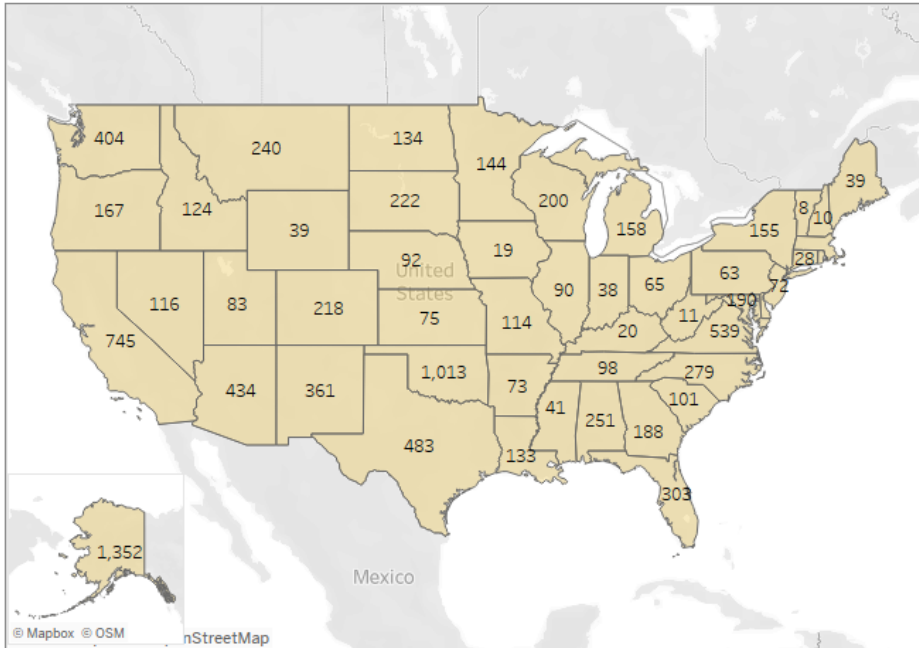

Common Terms and Acronyms

IEE: Indian Economic Enterprise (this includes both small and other than small businesses)

ISBEE: Indian Small Business Economic Enterprise

Set Aside to IEE: An award that was set aside to an IEE using the Buy Indian Act Authority indicates that when the solicitation was posted, it only allowed for IEEs to provide a proposal and be eligible for the resulting contract award.
