The Northern Virginia SAME Post was chartered as the Fort Belvoir Post December 10, 1948, as SAME's then 43rd local post. On 3 August 2000, the Post changed its name from Fort Belvoir to Northern Virginia. The Northern Virginia Post's core geographical area including Fairfax, Loudoun, and Prince William Counties.
