Expert speakers discuss how to effectively navigate the current Architecture, Construction, and Engineering Federal Contracting business landscape and how to position your firm contractually to ensure successful projects. Identification of risks and successfully mitigating them will also be discussed at the lunch meeting. Michael Sabellico, Senior Procurement Advisor, San Diego, Orange, and Imperial Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTAC). Mike will discuss on how to leverage available business development tools and programs for Architect, Construction, and Engineering Contractors in the Federal Contracting Opportunities landscape. He is a 20-year US Coast Guard veteran with several Command Cadre tours, and has significant Maritime, and Emergency Response experience ranging from Search and Rescue and Maritime counter smuggling efforts to Hurricane and natural disaster response. After leaving the USCG, he managed a robust business development program for a San Diego based defense contractor with offices throughout the US before leaving to create Vanguard Global Solutions, a Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business.
