Ryan deferred the July meeting minutes until next month.

Brian Schuele offered the "year to date Budget report" and the "end of July & end of August Income reports" for consideration by the board. Questions ensued from several members, until Bill Glismann moved acceptance; without objection, motion passed.

Young Member & College Outreach – Discussion ensued however that the Big Red Welcome for the NU (at UNL) Student Chapter, and the Joslyn Museum trip for the Metro Chapter. Stephanie Ling moved, and Bobbi Lang seconded, that we join the Greater Omaha Chamber of Commerce as a non-profit organization; motion carried on unanimous voice vote.

Leadership & Mentoring – Tom Svoboda reported the SMP Orientation event is scheduled for September 19th. Tom is also suggesting we look to the Pikes Peak Post's example for Fellows' matchmaking. Later, Anne Peterson added that "the 2023-2024 SMP starts on September 19 with an Orientation Dinner at Scott Conference Center at 5:30-7. Board members are invited, and please let Nicole Hunter know if you plan to attend so she can get a confirmation on numbers for food."

"Would like to do a program for our students at Kiewit Luminarium sometime this fall--limit attendance to 100 students, cost maybe \$1500-2500 depending on what the Luminarium works out with us. This will help inspire teams for projects plus inject more STEM content into their SAME exposure."

Scholarships & Camps – Tom reported that we will publicly announce future offerings at the September general membership meeting.

Awards & Recognition – Stephanie Heibel is updating the "system" (spreadsheet) and will reach out to all VPs to schedule one-on-one meetings.

Communication – Chris Atrz briefed the new Post website.

Professional Development & Personal Growth – Kandi Srb mentioned split kitty tickets are now available and we will provide prior purchased tickets at the September general meeting. [Note: the Program is updated on the schedule on the first page.] Subsequent to the meeting, Karlus announced his resignation as Chair of the Programs committee; a new POC is being recruited.

Resilience – NSTR. Reviewing POCs with Nebraska Emergency Management Agency to renew relationships.

Veterans Outreach – Rob Hufford briefed "PHWFF is hosting their National Fly Casting competition in Arkansas in August. I don't have the full details but they're sending in multiple Veterans from across the Country to cast and compete. As a fundraiser to help support travels, lodging, meals, etc, as well to commemorate the event, they're making shirts that will be given to all of the competitors and volunteers in attendance. We're not sending anyone to volunteer but will be making a donation towards the shirts. Will advise on that task when complete."

Relationships – Bobbi Lang reports significant growth in National's posting of corporate and individual members. She introduced UNL Professor Tony Roebuck, the faculty advisor for the NU student chapter.
