DREDGE POTTER TOUR & LUNCH

Time: 11 am - 2 pm
Place: AREC Building, 100 Arsenal St., St. Louis, MO 63118

The SAME St. Louis Post will be touring the Dredge *Potter*, the USACE's oldest operating dredge. Lunch will be served at 11:30 am, prior to the Dredge *Potter* tour. Please register using the link to the left so we can get a count for lunch. Cost of the lunch is \$15 per person.

Built in 1932, the *Potter* operates on 200 miles of the Mississippi River (from Hannibal to Cairo), as well as 80 miles of the Illinois River and 36 miles of the Kaskaskia River.

For your safety, please wear long pants with safety boots. Open-toed shoes will not be allowed to tour the dredge. Please do not bring any firearms with you or in your vehicle since you are entering into a secured Federal facility. Security guards will ask for that your name be provided to them. The guards will direct you to the parking area adjacent to the AREC building. There are numerous stairs to access the dredge, and there is no elevator.

Attendees also had opportunities to network and participate in roundtables with agency representatives.

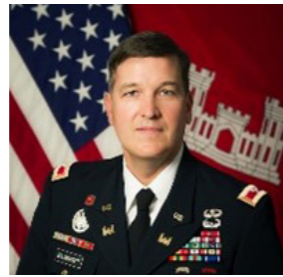

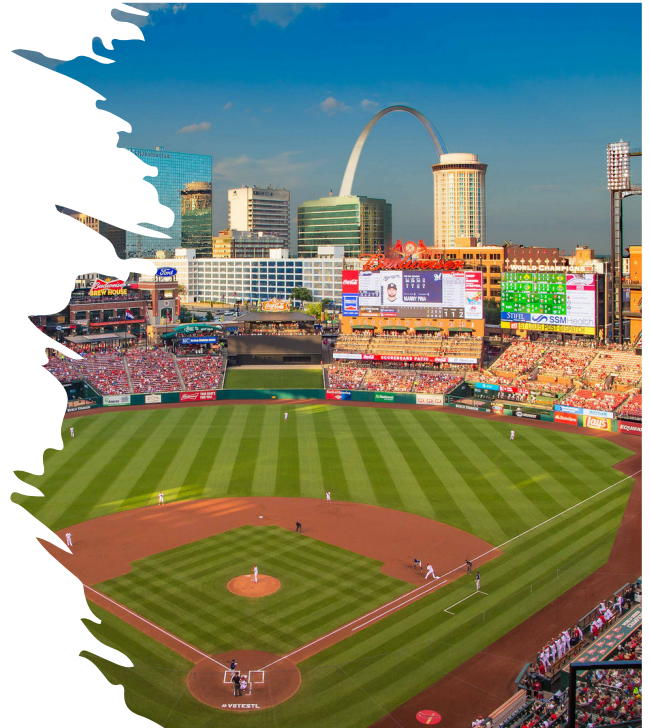
