Program Details

<u>Speaker Bio:</u> Jasen Brown, PE, Engineering Lead of the Upper Mississippi River Restoration (UMRR) Program, St. Louis District, USACE. Jasen Brown graduated from the University of Missouri at Rolla (now Missouri University of Science and Technology) in 2004 with a Bachelor's of Science in Civil Engineering. Including my years as a student / COOP, Jasen has been with the USACE, St. Louis District for 20 years including his years as a student employee. Jasen's current role is the Engineering Lead of the Upper Mississippi River Restoration (UMRR) Program within the St. Louis District. He handles project management duties, as well as ensuring design consistency and efficiency of construction and Operations and Maintenance across all St. Louis District UMRR projects.

<u>Description:</u> *St. Louis District's Upper Mississippi River Restoration (UMRR) Program.* The Upper Mississippi River Restoration (UMRR) Program is authorized by the Water Resources Development Act of 1986 and was the first environmental restoration and monitoring program undertaken on a large river system in the United States. Since its creation, it has come to be recognized as the single most important effort committed to ensuring the viability and vitality of the Upper Mississippi River System's (UMRS) diverse and significant fish and wildlife resources since establishment of the National Wildlife Refuges on that system in the 1920s. Since 1986, the St. Louis District UMRR Program has partnered with federal, state, and local organizations to design and construct many Habitat Restoration and Enhancement (HREP) projects. The strength of the UMRR Program in St. Louis continues today, with multiple efforts in the planning, design, or construction phases of the project life cycle in the pooled reaches of the St. Louis District (River Miles 300 - 195) as well as the open (no locks and dams) reach of the Mississippi River (River Miles 195-0).


