Candidates receive additional consideration if they are active members of a Student Post of the Society of American Military Engineers.

- A certified copy of your college transcript of your grades
- · A Letter of Recommendation from a commanding officer, academic adviser, or instructor/professor

All requested information must be received by end of day Friday, June 17, 2022.
