

Roadway Capacity Reductions


On a three-lane roadway closing, one lane reduces the capacity to 49%

Number of Lanes	If Shoulder Blocked	Lanes Blocked		
		1	2	3
3	83%	49%	17%	0%

Studies indicate that the likelihood of a secondary incident increases 2.8% for each minute that a lane is blocked

1 Minute = 4 Minutes

Lanes Blocked = Delay


