















Modeled Storage in Travis and Buchanan in 2115








Number of Reservoirs with Conservation Storage Greater than 5,000 acre-feet












Statewide Survey of Aquifer Suitability for Aquifer Storage and Recovery Projects or Aquifer Recharge Projects [Abridged]










