First cashless Tollway in Illinois, with 10 miles of high-speed roadway




NORTHBOUND I-294 MILE LONG BRIDGE

New northbound structure opened to traffic in November 2020




MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM AWARDS

VETERANS PROGRAM

In 2015, the Illinois Tollway became one of the first state agencies to establish veteran goals

Since 2015

More than \$95.1 million has been paid to certified veteran-owned firms, including

- More than \$58.3 million in construction
- More than \$36.7 million in professional engineering services

27 contracts have been awarded to veteran-owned firms, including



23 professional engineering services contracts

CENTRAL TRI-STATE TOLLWAY (I-294) PROJECT

Reconstruct 22 miles and invest \$4 billion



ILLINOIS ROUTE 390 TOLLWAY AND I-490 TOLLWAY PROJECT


Provide 17 miles of new roads and invest \$3.6 billion

MAJOR WORK SCHEDULED FOR 2022

- Mainline reconstruction 95th Street to I-55, Flagg Creek to Cermak Road and St. Charles Road to Wolf Road
- Roadway rehabilitation and widening Wolf Road to O'Hare Oasis
- I-290/I-88 Interchange reconstruction at I-294
- Completion of the St. Charles Road Interchange reconstruction
- Completion of the BNSF Railway Bridge reconstruction
- Southbound Mile Long Bridge reconstruction
- I-55 Interchange reconstruction






I-490 Tollway Project Overview



















12 MAINTENANCE FACILITIES LOCATED ACROSS 294-MILE SYSTEM

Each facility is responsible for 25-30 miles of roadway and staffed with 25-44 full-time personnel

Facilities include

 Vehicle parking, maintenance garage, storage buildings, salt storage, truck wash, Illinois State Police District 15 squad and training rooms
