<u>SAME-NP Scholarship Purpose:</u> To encourage and assist qualified students who wish to pursue a college education in the field of engineering, architecture, mathematics, computer science, or related field so that they, in turn, might further the mission, vision, and values of SAME.

<u>Terms:</u> Scholarships are for academic year 2024 - 2025. The scholarship must be used during the 2024 - 2025 academic year. Any excess must be returned to the Society of American Military Engineers Nashville Post.



### SAME NASHVILLE POST SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM DETAILS 2024 - 2025 Academic Year

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- 1. Applicant must meet at least one of the following membership requirements:
  - a. A current member of the SAME Nashville Post (SAME-NP), or
- b. Son/daughter, grandson/granddaughter, or under legal guardianship of an active or deceased member of the SAME-NP (where active member is defined as being a current member who has held membership for one continuous year or longer at the time of the application), or
- d. Son/daughter, grandson/granddaughter, or under legal guardianship of an employee (or retired employee) of a current SAME-NP sustaining member firm or the Nashville U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, or
- e. Employee of a current SAME-NP sustaining member firm or Nashville U.S. Army Corps of Engineers
- 2. Must be a college student (undergraduate or graduate) or enrolled to start college classes.
- 3. Must have a minimum grade point average of a B.
- 4. Must be accepted by or attending an ABET accredited college or university studying engineering, or accredited college or university studying architecture, mathematics, computer science or related fields of study.

### Selection Criteria to be considered by SAME-NP scholarship committee:

- 1. Graduating high school applicants: SAT or ACT test results. If scores are not available please explain why.
- 2. Grade point average.
- 3. Recommendation by a current in-major professor/teacher, in-major faculty advisor or guidance counselor.
- 4. Required major in engineering, architecture, mathematics, computer science or related field.
- 5. Evidence of serious scholastic attitude, good character, leadership qualities, and well-rounded personal development.
- 6. Preference to students with military aspirations as exemplified by enrollment in Officer Training program or previous military service.
- 7. Studies, volunteerism, activities, and work that represent SAME's mission, vision, and values.

#### 2024 Schedule:

March: Application Available

March 1 – April 15: Applications accepted (submitted no later than April 15).

May: Notification of awards to scholarship recipients.

June/July: Distribution of scholarship funds (directly to college or university).
