



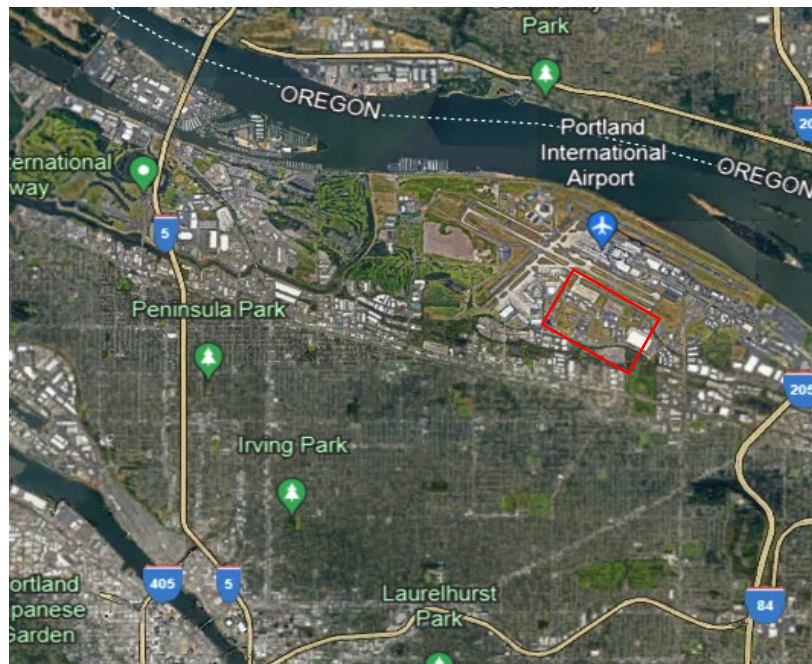

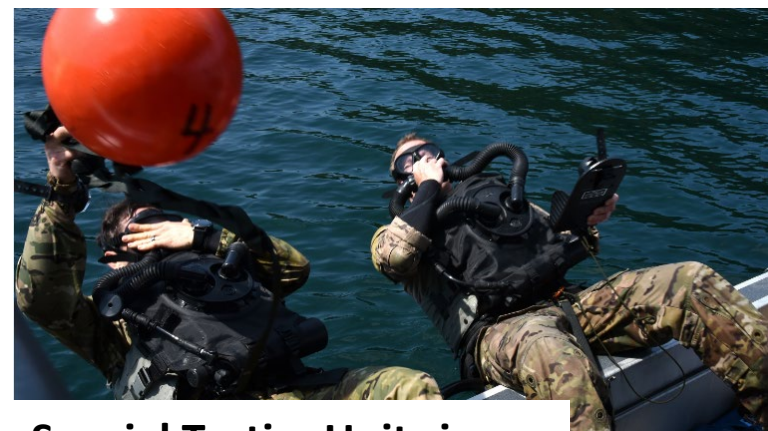

First Operational F-15EX Arrives in Oregon; Milestone for Air Guard

The first operational F-15EX Eagle II was delivered to Portland Air National Guard Base, Ore., on June 6, the first all-new weapon system to be delivered to the Air Guard before serving with the Active-Duty force.

The aircraft, serial #008, is the first of 18 that will serve with the 142nd Wing of the Oregon Air National Guard. Another 13 are slated to arrive within the next year, and four more in the

What Makes the Guard Different?

- Air National Guard has the authority to execute MILCON outside typical military construction avenues
 - Primary Method is contracting through United States Property and Fiscal Office (USPFO) within the State
 - Secondary Methods include:
 - Military Construction Cooperative Agreement with any State/Local Government Agency with USPFO Approval
 - USACE and NAVFAC with NGB/AQ Approval
 - Any other Federal Construction Agent with NGB/AQ Approval

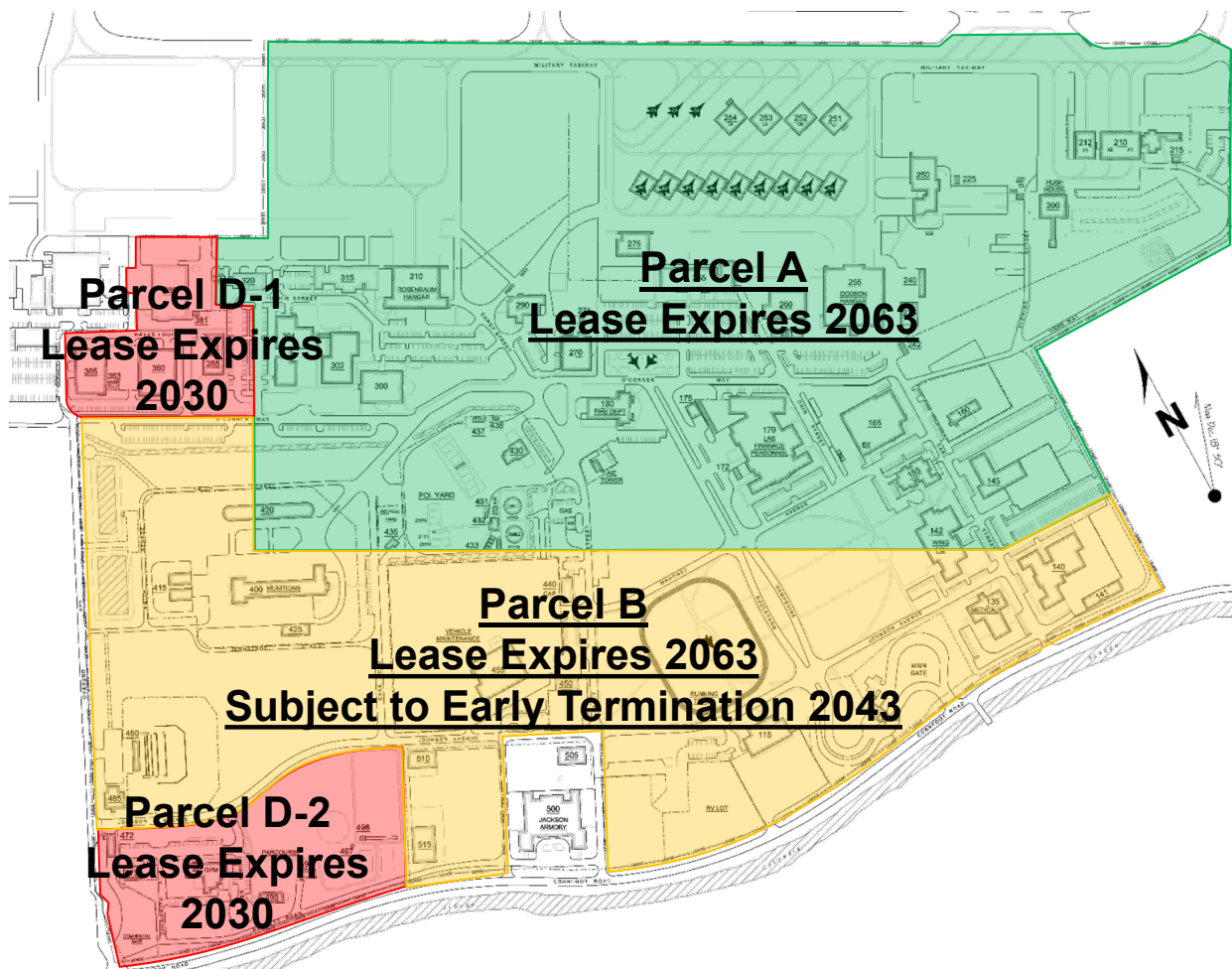
- Program allows guard unit to contract directly through state contracting office

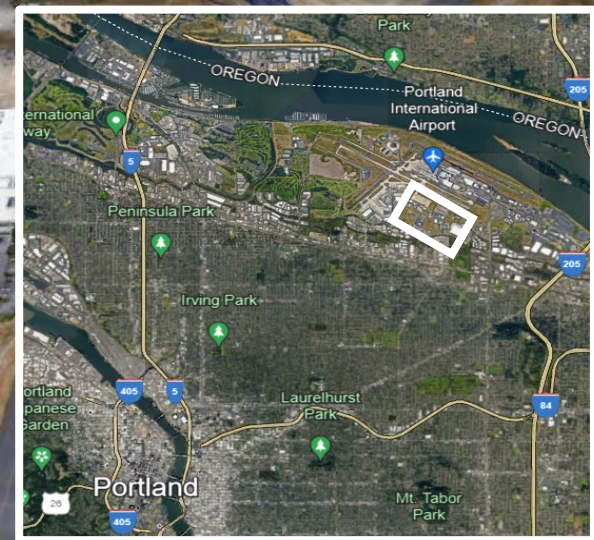




Major Efforts on Base

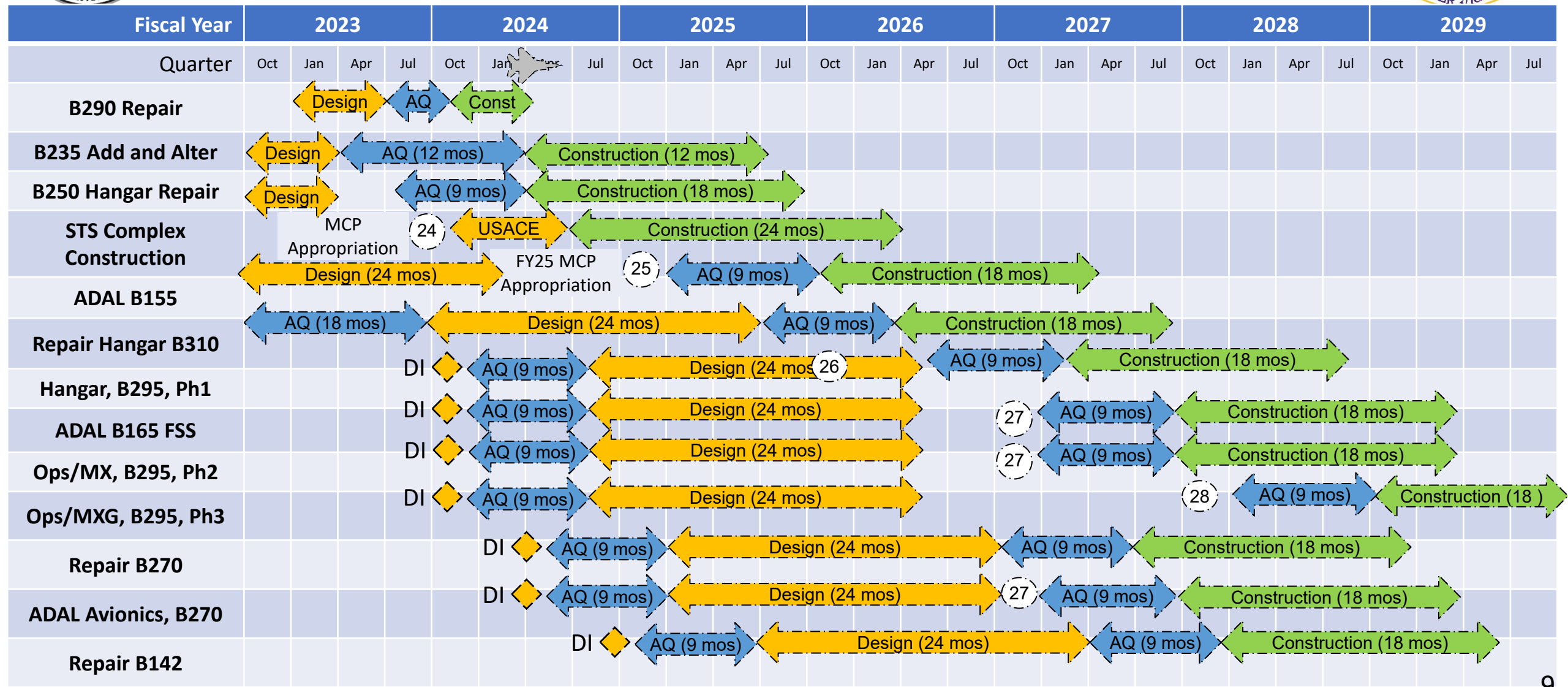
