

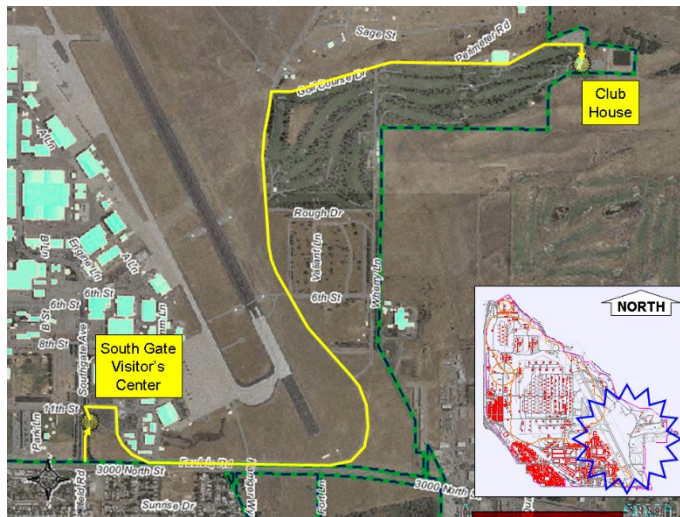
28th Annual SAME Great Basin Post Student Scholarship Golf Tournament

Cost: \$75.00 each (\$60.00 for military, DoD civilians and retirees), includes green fee and ½ cart, lunch and prizes.
