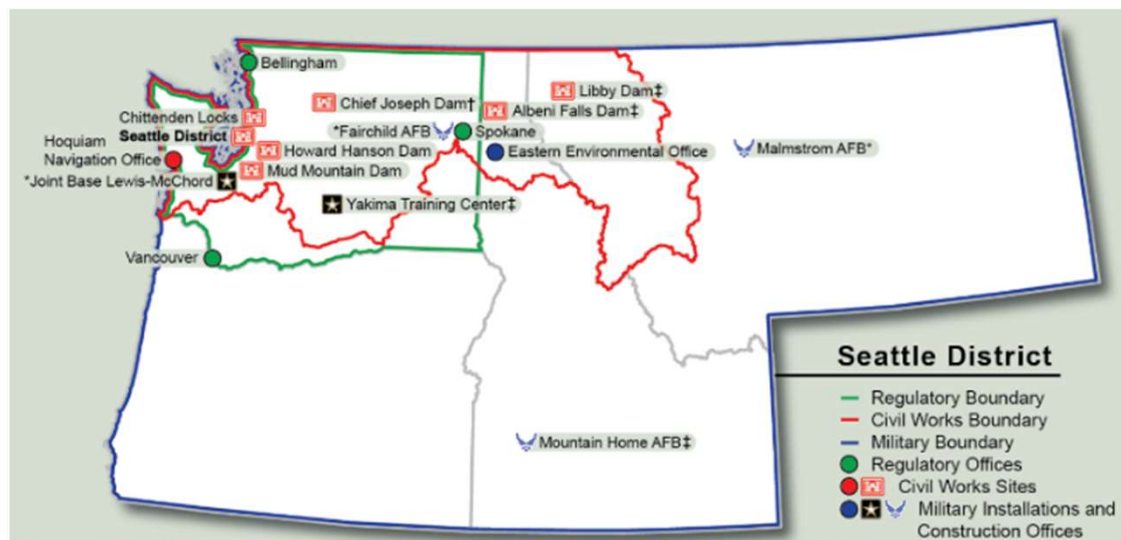

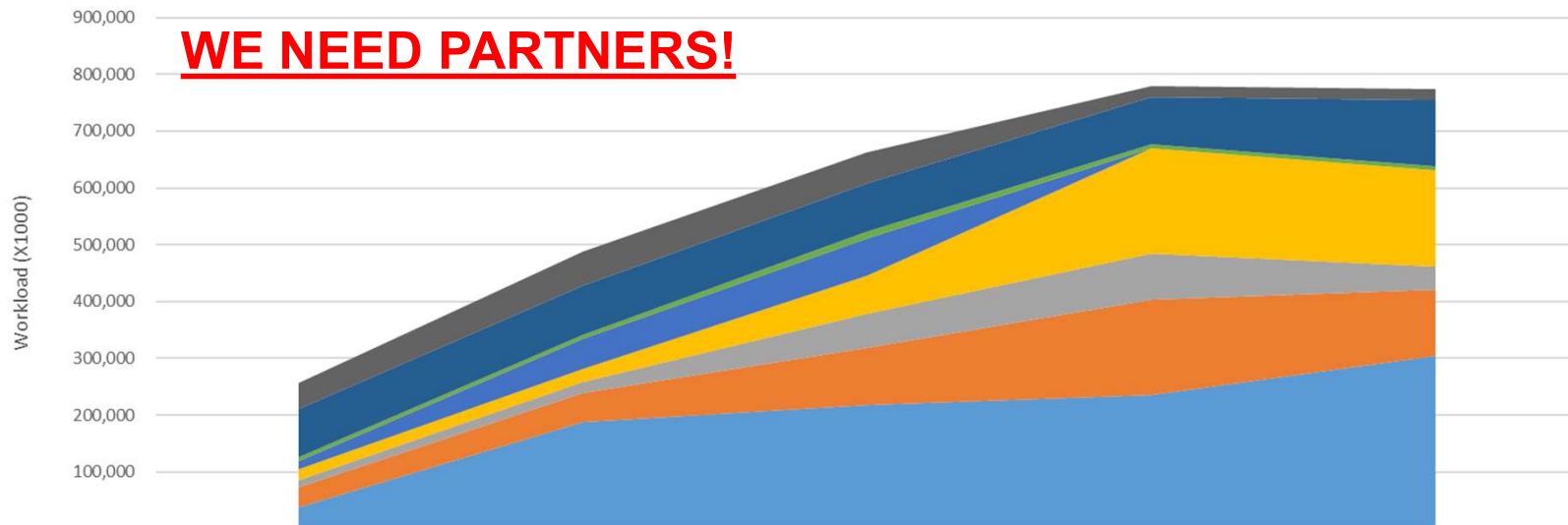




FIVE YEAR WORKLOAD PROJECTIONS (MILITARY, IIS, ENVIRONMENTAL)

Purpose:

This Engineering and Construction Bulletin (ECB) establishes policy requiring Project Delivery Teams (PDTs) to consider mass timber solutions when designing Army MILCON and Civil Works vertical construction projects. It also highlights US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and industry mass timber design resources.

Applicability:

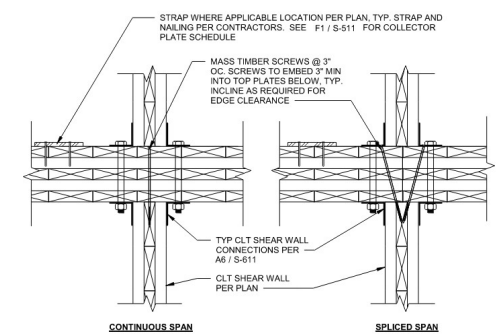
This ECB applies to all Army MILCON and Civil Works vertical construction projects starting in the FY23 program year and beyond. It is highly recommended for all other MILCON projects and work for others within the Directorate of Military Programs.

Background:

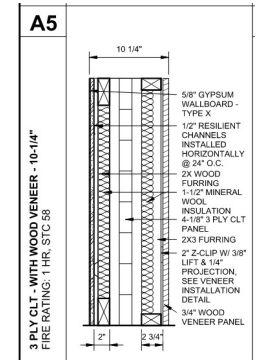
Mass timber refers to a category of engineered wood products, consisting of multiple solid wood panels nailed or glued together for strength and flexibility. Examples of products in the mass timber family include but are not limited to cross-laminated timber (CLT), glue-laminated timber (Glulam or GLT), dowel laminated timber (DLT), nail laminated timber (NLT), and laminated veneer lumber (LVL).
