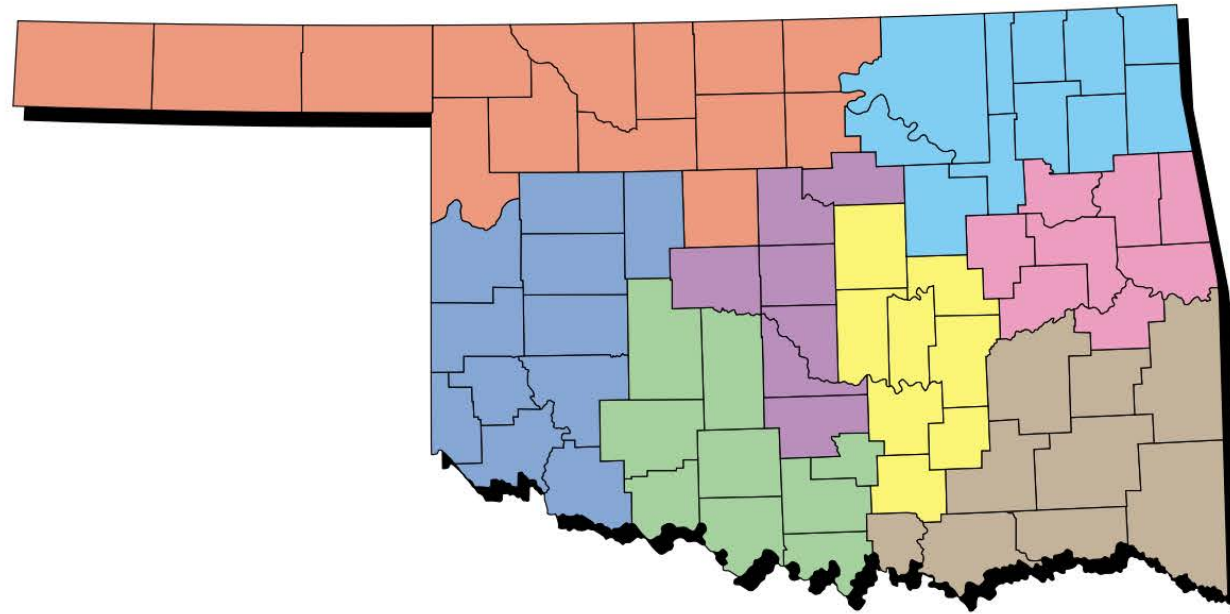


County Improvements for Roads and Bridges (CIRB)

- \$150 Million/year of state funding dedicated to construction or reconstruction of county roads and bridges.
- CIRB funds match \$34 million in federal funds allocated annually for county projects.
- CIRB funds are also used to match Tribal Nations' funding on some projects

- Projects are selected and updated by the counties and Circuit Engineering Districts (CEDs)

Bridge Formula Program (BFP) SD City Bridges & Scour Mitigation

- \$15M per year for scour mitigation (city & county)
- \$10M per year for city bridges
- \$3M per year for engineering

ODOT will invest \$140M on off-system bridges over the next five years



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Scour Repairs

- Grouted Rip Rap
- Pile/Column Protection
- Curtain Walls
- Debris Removal
- Sheet Piling
- Slope Stability



City Bridge Replacement

- Must be structurally deficient
- Must be within city limits
- Must be 20' in length and have an NBI number

Funded provided through the **IIJA Bill** - Competitive
Application Process

Safety Components of TAP

- ADA-compliant sidewalks and trails
- Bicycle infrastructure
- Pedestrian and bicycle signals
- Traffic calming techniques
- Streetscapes or Enhancements
- Lighting and other safety-related infrastructure



\$52 million in projects were awarded funding in 2022



ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS AND FUNDING CATEGORIES

- Governmental Entities
 - Local governments
 - Regional Transportation Authorities
 - Transit agencies
 - Natural resource or public lands agencies
 - School Districts, local education agencies or schools
 - Tribal governments
 - A metropolitan planning organization that serves an urbanized area with a population of 200,000 or fewer
 - A nonprofit entity.
- Anticipated Funding Categories
 - Under 5,000 (100% Design 90/10 Const.)
 - 5,000 – 49,999 (80/20 Design/Const.)
 - 50,000 – 200,000 (80/20 Design/Const.)
 - > 200,000 (ACOG and INCOG)(under 15,000 2020 population eligible to apply for statewide funding. All others will apply through ACOG or INCOG)



TAP PROCESS PRIOR TO AWARD

- TAP Projects are Awarded Through a Competitive Application Process
 - Current funding (fully allocated) is provided by the IJA Bill.
 - During the application process, ODOT Local Government staff provides technical assistance and guidance
 - Applications are completed on-line
 - Application scoring criteria is provided in the Implementation Manual
 - Applications are scored by committee and recommended for award to the ODOT Senior Leadership and Transportation Commission
 - Transportation Commission awards projects at ODOT Commission Meeting

Emergency Relief Program



- Must be a minimum of \$700,000 (federal share) in damage from event
- Provides assistance for emergency and permanent repairs
- Damage must be on a major collector road or higher
- Make sure damage is thoroughly documented before and after repairs are made

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Environmental Study Services

- Environmental studies for transportation improvement projects generally on the County Transportation System
- Requires the completion of appropriate Environmental Studies and Coordination for Non-Federally funded county projects statewide per the latest version of the *Instructions and Guidance for the Regulatory Provisions Checklist for Non-FHWA Funded Projects.*



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Geotechnical Investigation Services

- Requires providing roadway and bridge-related geotechnical investigations in support of Local Public Agency (LPA) staff for the design of transportation structures at locations throughout the state. All services will be rendered regarding applicable AASHTO and ASTM specifications, also as may be required under Chapter 13 and Chapter 14 of the latest County Road Design Manual or other project Specific Special Provisions.

Land/Aerial Survey Services

- Land Survey services for transportation improvement projects on the County road system.
- These services may include, but are not limited to:
 - location surveys (to be used for environmental purposes and in the development of construction plans),
 - land or aerial surveys (for determining property ownership and the acquisition of right-of-way, staking right-of-way), and
 - other types of land or aerial surveys as required by the LPA.
- This requires a licensed Professional Land Surveyor holding a current license in the State of Oklahoma.

New firms interested in being pre-qualified for Local Government Services

- New firms may submit qualifications at any time, under the View Contract Solicitations link located on the left-hand side of the TOPS Home page. Note: you must have an active TOPS user ID to submit your firm's qualifications for review. You can log in to TOPS or create a user ID here.

Existing pre-qualified firms wanting to update qualifications/personnel or renew pre-qualification status

- Existing firms should update qualifications under the View Contract Solicitations_Local Government Pre-Qualification solicitation any time there is a change in personnel and are required to re-qualify every 4 years to remain on the pre-qualified list. To view your firm's current pre-qualification status, including renewal due dates, use the below link.

Local Government Pre-qualification Opportunities

The Local Government Pre-Qualification process allows firms to submit their qualifications for review by ODOT subject matter experts. Qualifications submitted will be evaluated and firms determined to be qualified will be included on a pre-qualification list that is available for use by Local Public Agencies (LPAs) for projects involving the Department.

A Letter of Interest (LOI) can be submitted at any time for firms seeking pre-qualification for the first time or for those who are currently pre-qualified but need to make revisions to their qualifications or key-personnel listed on their team.

If your firm has previously been pre-qualified, your firm remains pre-qualified and on the current list for 4 years. Re-qualification will occur during the 4th year and is the responsibility of the consultant to submit for consideration prior to the published renewal due date.


Instructions and LOI Packet Requirements:

Your submission for each service you're interested in being pre-qualified for should be no more than 10 pages plus any [CAP 255](#) pages and include the following:

- Letter of Interest (LOI) referencing the service for which you are interested in being considered (LG-0001 - LG-0006) (a separate LOI for each service should be submitted)
- Table of Organization depicting the proposed team
- A statement of your qualifications **including prime and any sub-consultants** on [CAP 255 Form rev. 07/2020](#)
- Additional information you believe appropriate for use in determining your qualifications

Your response must be submitted in [TOPS](#) under the Local Government Pre-qualification Solicitation for both new pre-qualifications and renewals.
