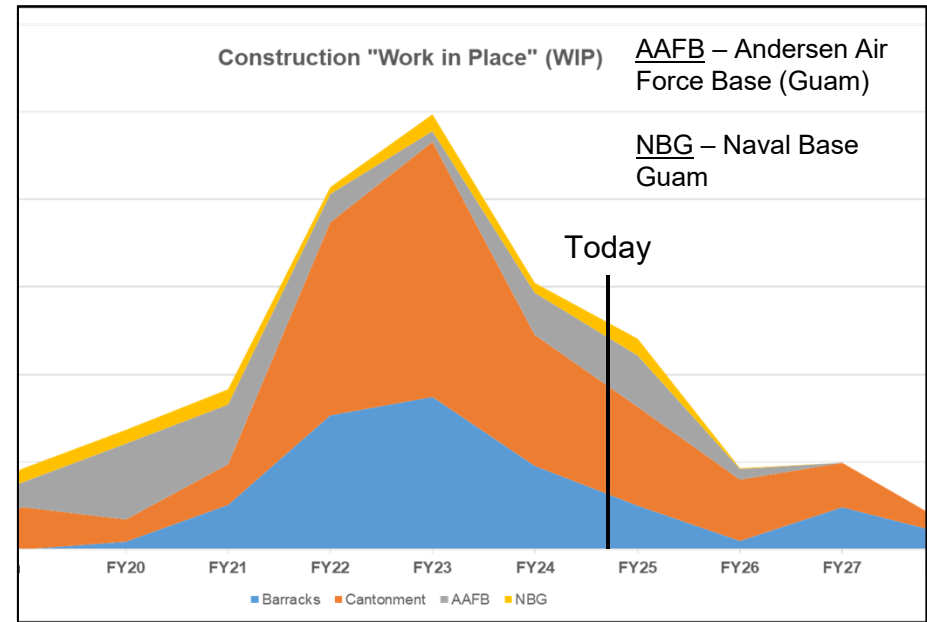
Shipyard Infrastructure Optimization Program (SIOP)

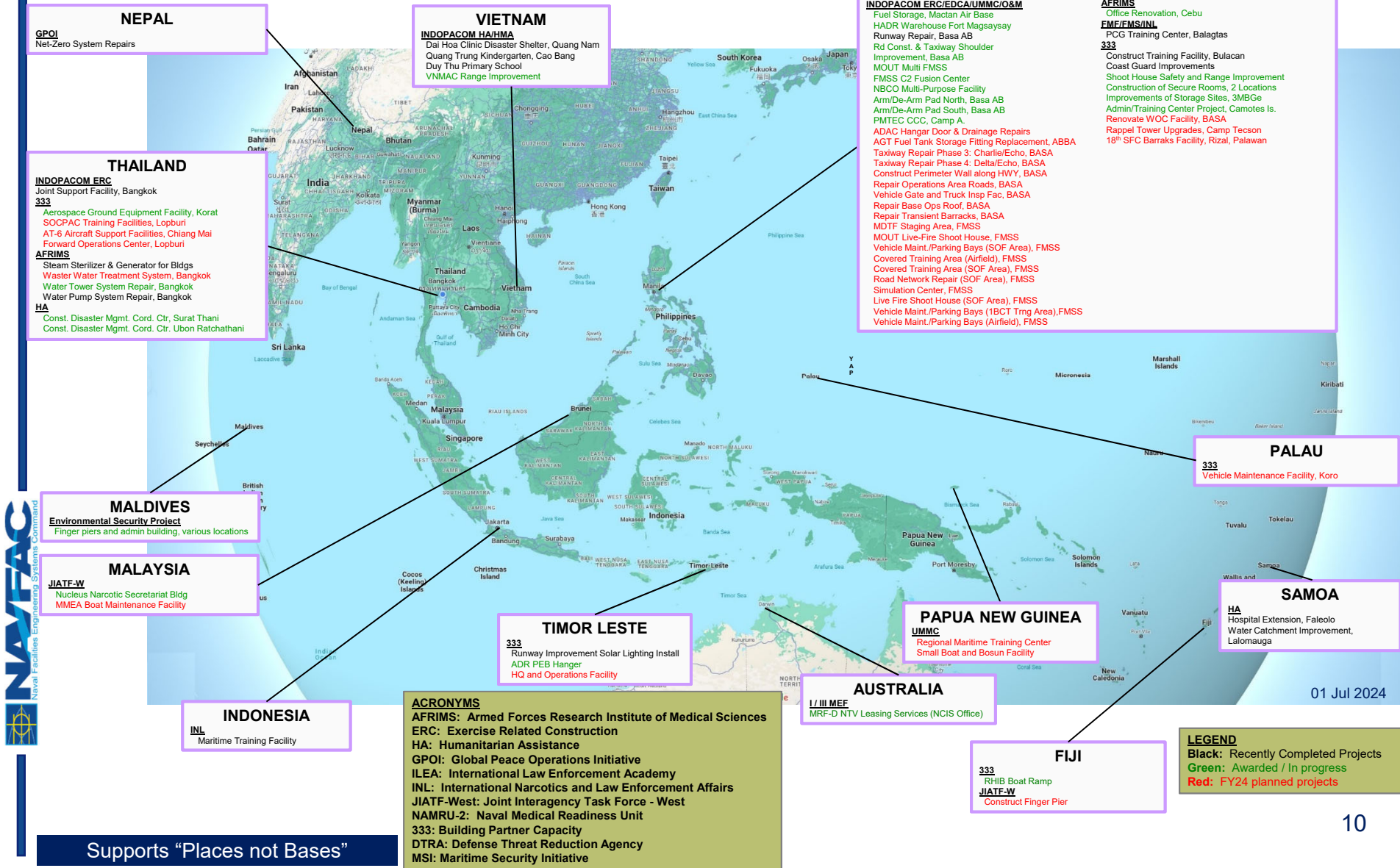

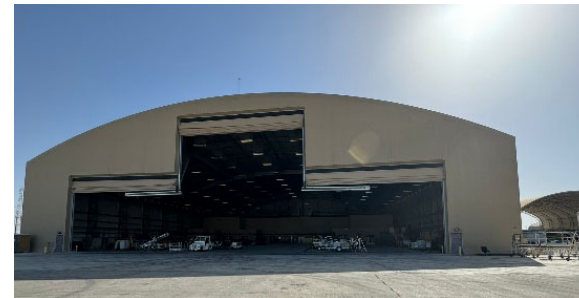

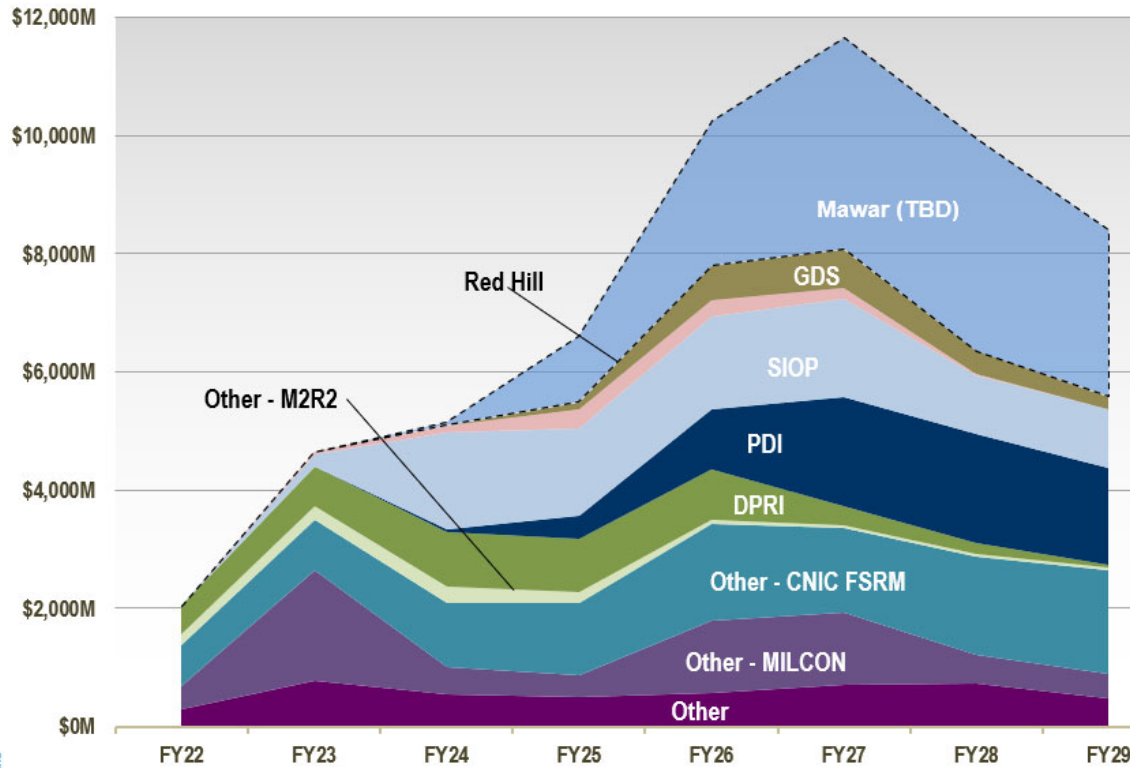

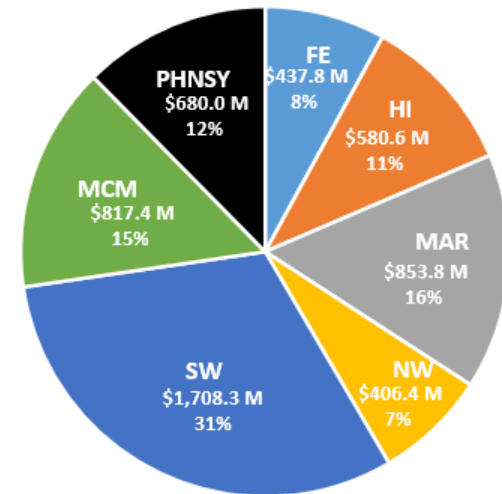

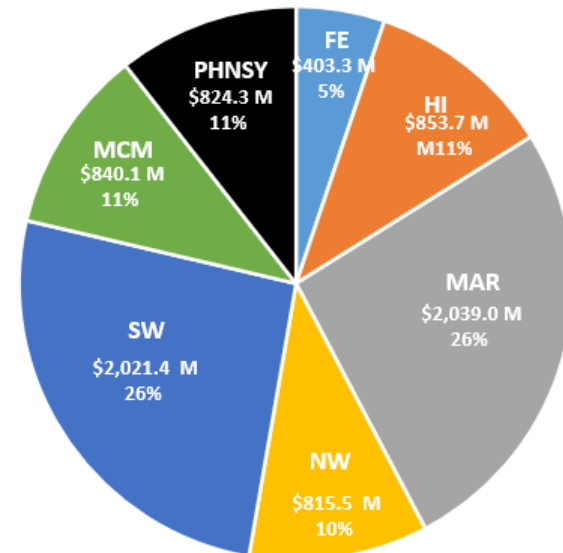
FY25+ Work In Progress Forecast (by Program)
