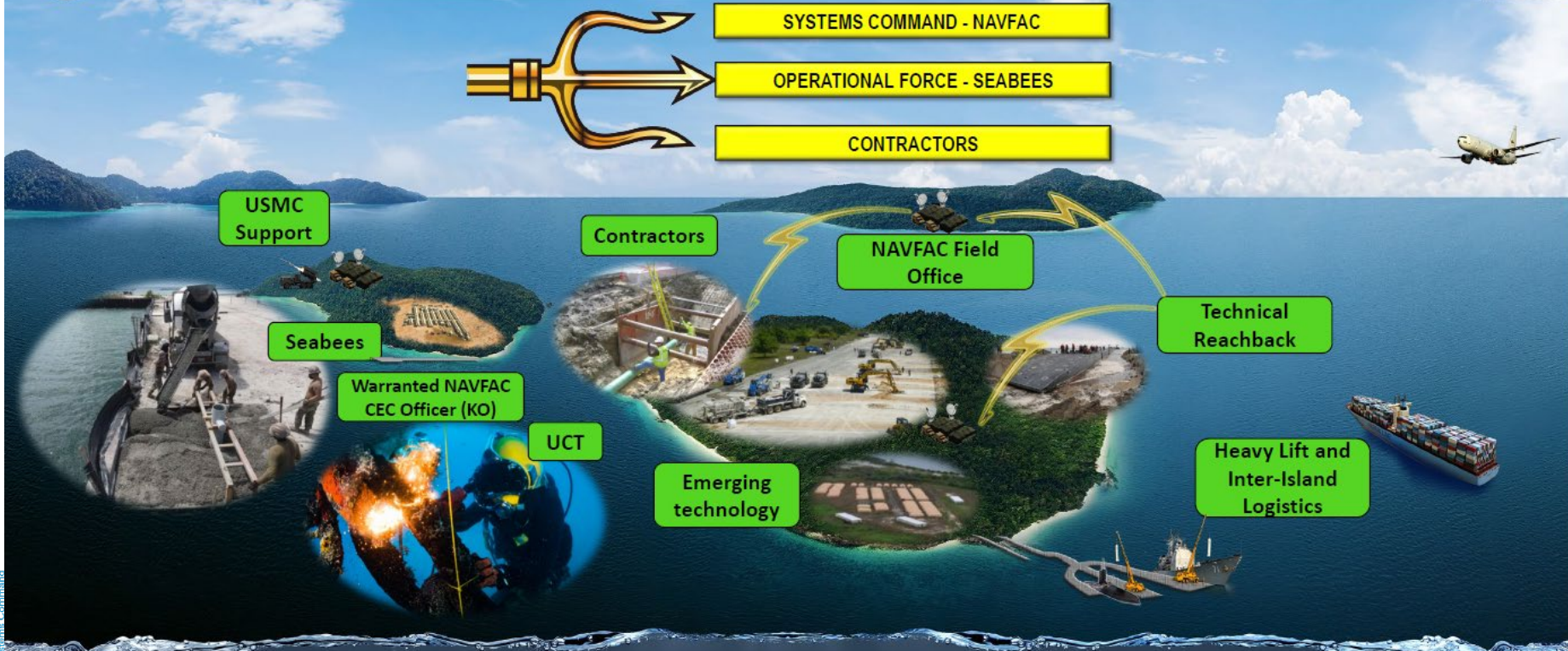

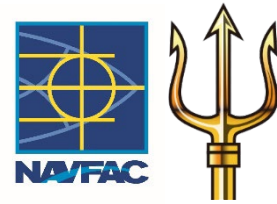

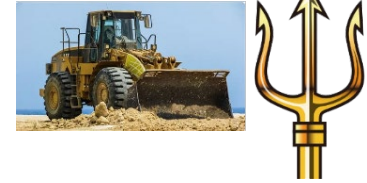

Poseidon's Corollary – Seabees



- **Reinforce chain of command through formal tasking & governance**
 - PACFLT → 3rd Fleet → ACB / NCG 1
 - PACFLT → 7th Fleet → CTF 75 → CTG 75.5 (30 NCR)
 - PACFLT N46 requirement validation with INDOPACOM
- **NCF Force Distribution (FY25 and beyond)**
 - Additional Seabees in the Pacific
 - Define, prioritize, and coordinate OPLAN mission execution
- **PACFLT Engineer Initiatives**
 - NCF inspection tour (Port Hueneme and Gulfport)
 - Integrated Fleet Exercises
 - Work Induction
 - Naval Component & Joint Force Engineer synergies
 - OPLAN updates



Poseidon's Corollary – Contractors

- **Wartime Acquisition Response Plan**
 - **13-15 Mar 2024, NFP requested (5) GCSMAC Contractors to describe their technical approach to contingency contracting challenges to three exercise scenarios**
 - Scenario 1 (Ph 0): Provide shipping, receiving, storage, transportation services
 - Scenario 2 (Ph II): Support port logistics requirements and establish a work force to manage port services
 - Scenario 3 (Ph III): Establish a work force and manage airfield facilities services



Poseidon's Corollary – Contractors

Identified Risks

- Environmental and legal requirements
- Force protection: Who has responsibility – contractor, GOV, or both?
- Key equipment / resource availability in Phase I and II:
 - Cranes at ports
 - Airfield fuel
 - Skilled labor (e.g. crane operators, mechanics, airfield operations SMEs)
- Loss of key support infrastructure:
 - Ports
 - Airfields
 - Shipping lanes

Mitigation Considerations

- Incorporate COFA / SOFA and duty / tax exemption references in Contracts
- Define Responsibilities
- Prepositioning of key resources and supplies

WARP Exercise Way Forward

- Conduct at SECRET level
- Create task order templates for review by contractors prior to execution
- Consider collaborative contract approach

- Guam Defense System (GDS) / Missile Defense of Guam
- Polaris Point
- Marine Corps Base Camp Blaz
- Typhoon Mawar
- INDOPACOM Posture Projects
- Increases Seabee Presence
