# The Indo-Pacific Area of Responsibility

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## Physical

- 52% of Earth's surface
- Over half the world's population (3.72 B)
- 36 countries
- 16 time zones

## Military

- 6 largest militaries
- 5 of 7 U.S. Mutual Defense Treaties
- 5 declared nuclear nations



## INDOPACOM

*The Pacific Ocean connects the United States to the Region ... it doesn't separate us*

## Cultural

- Most populous nation
- Largest democracy
- Largest Muslim-majority
- Smallest republic

## Economic

- 3 largest economies
- 5 smallest economies
- 9 of 10 largest ports
- Busiest Int'l sea lanes



# FY24 NDAA & UMMC Authorities

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## Authority Changes in the FY24 NDAA

- **Sec. 1807 H-2B Workers for Guam and CNMI to 31 Dec '29**
- **Sec. 2802 Unspecified Minor Military Construction (UMMC)**
  - Extends UMMC ceiling from \$6M to \$9M
  - Extends locality adjustment limit from \$10M to \$14M
- **Sec. 2803 Application of dollar limitations for UMMC projects to locations outside the United States**
  - Area Cost Factors apply to UMMC projects up to \$14M across the INDOPACOM AOR
- **Sec. 2805: Authority for certain construction projects in friendly foreign countries**
  - Allows SECDEF to approve projects up to \$15M in foreign countries for APODS, SPODS, or rail heads. O&M funds may also be used for Planning & Design.

- **Sec. 2810 Authority for Indo-Pacific Posture Unspecified Minor Military Construction Projects**
  - Authorizes INDOPACOM to carry out UMMC projects up to \$15M using O&M (up to \$8M) or the unappropriated INDOPACOM Military Construction Pilot Program.

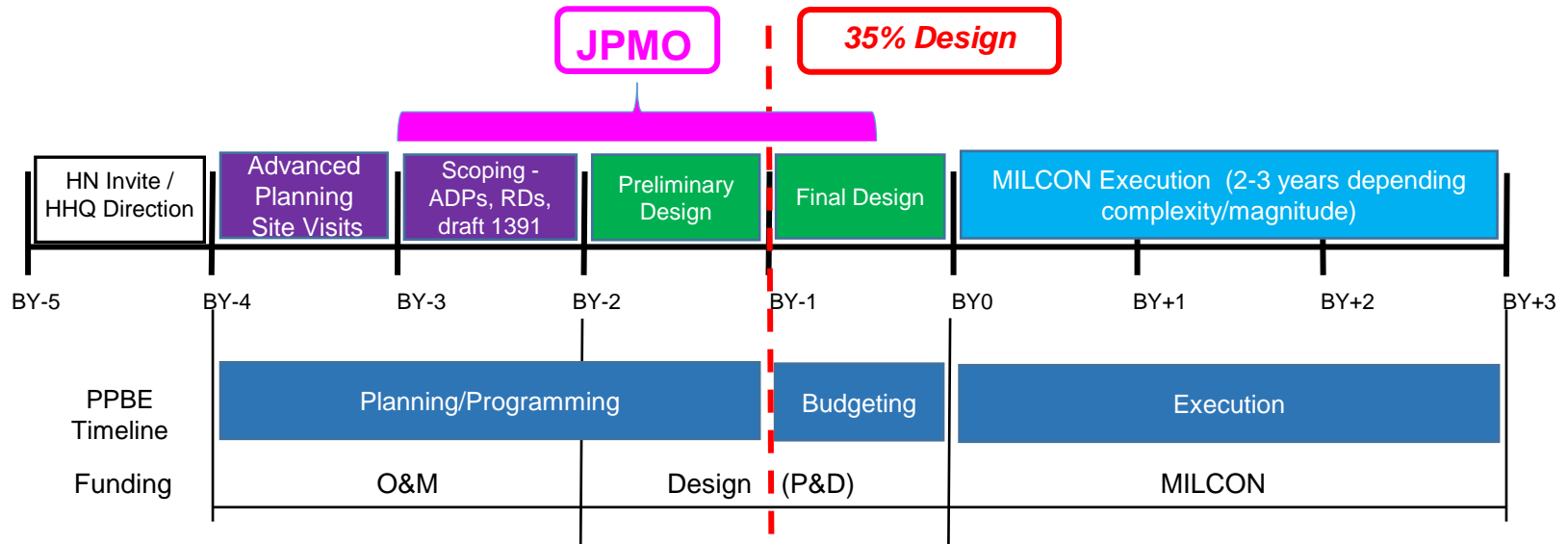
### FY25 Legislative Proposal

***LP 468 – Modification of the prohibition on cost-plus contracting allow cost-plus contracting for USINDOPACOM Posture Priority Projects subject to limitations and requirements***



# Expected Timeline for a MILCON Project

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• 2-3 years depending on complexity/magnitude

- *Requirements Validation*
- *Joint Area Development Plans*
- *Environmental Impact Assessments*
- *Site Surveys*
- *Initial DD1391 or Requirements Document*
- *Contract Preliminary Design (35%)*

The Joint Posture Management Office (JPMO) has focused on advanced planning and preliminary design to help lead service reduce MILCON timeline by 2-3 years

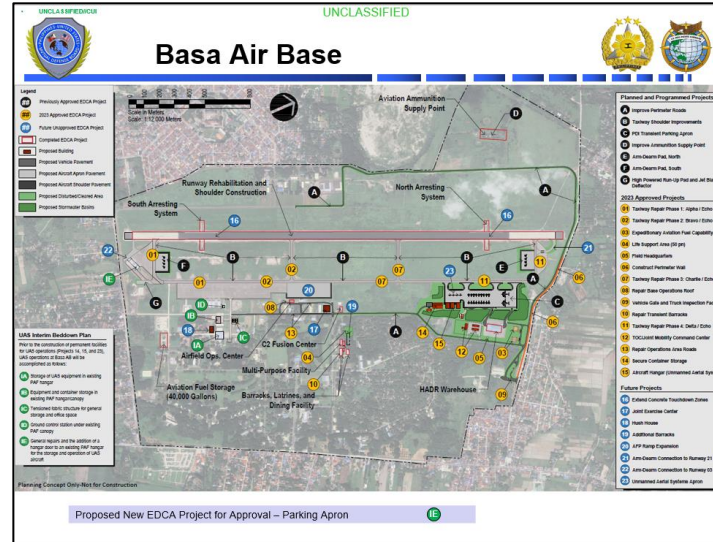

## ➤ JADPs are an infrastructure improvement strategy for posture locations, ie. “places without bases”

- Combines **JOINT** infrastructure requirements at a location
- De-conflicts service requirements and identifies shared use opportunities
- Identifies infrastructure gaps
- Proposes solutions that are beneficial to all parties
- Coordinates projects with partner nations / installations / stakeholders
- Supports DD1391 development, environmental documentation, host nation agreements
- Recommends a Lead Service / Resource Sponsor

## ➤ Challenges

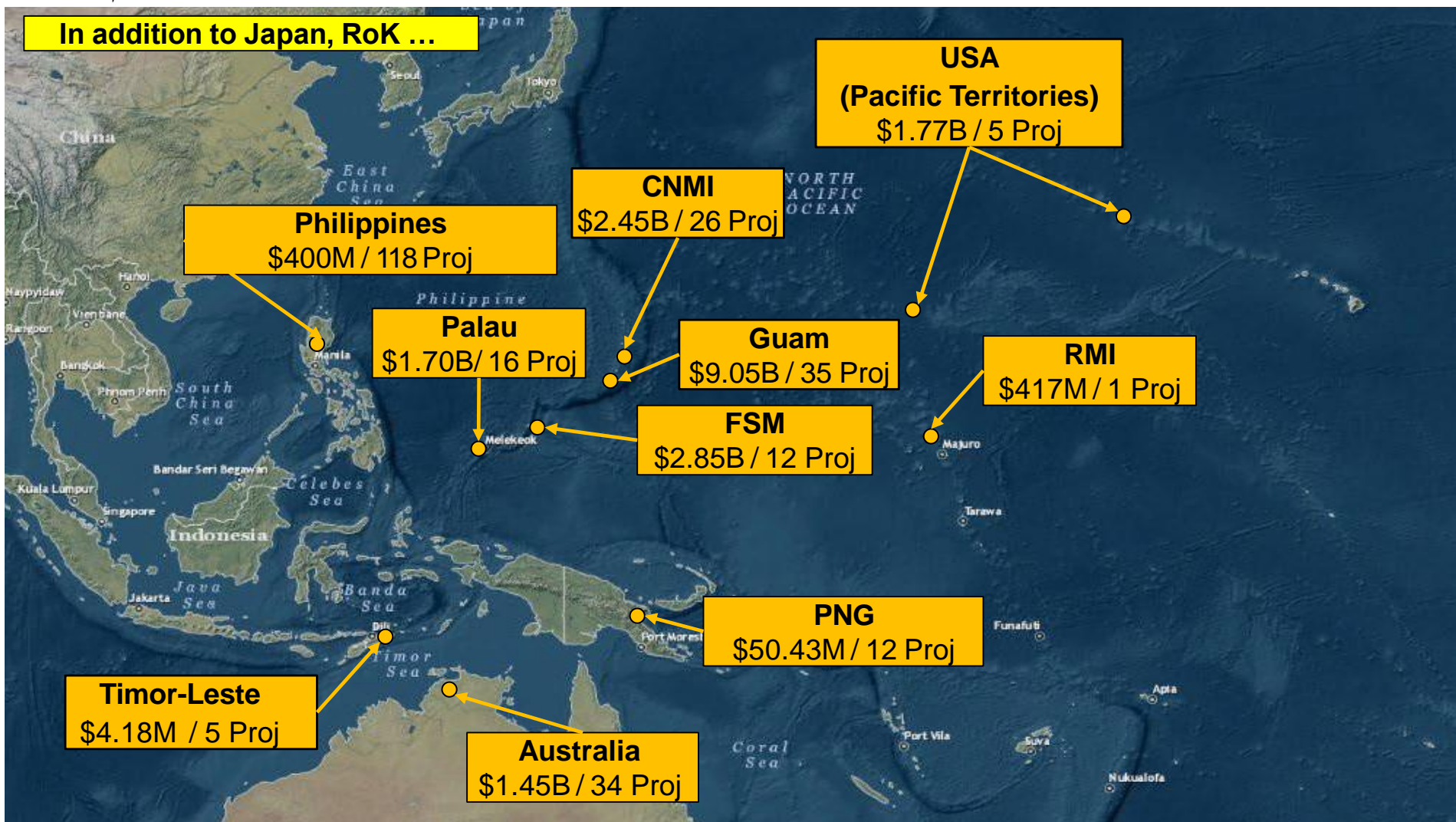
- Underdeveloped Component Requirements
- Limited or NO access to the locations
- Political sensitivities / no established planning process (in-person relationships, flexibility)
