

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
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FORT WORTH DISTRICT BOUNDARIES

Additional Topics for Discussion

- 1. Is USACE tracking the offer from Port San Antonio to provide a new, \$1 billion HQ for the 16th Air Force (Air Force Cyber) at Port SA (formerly Kelly AFB) using an Inter-Governmental Support Agreement (IGSA)? Port SA gets critical political backing for Air Forces Cyber HQ plan (sanantonioreport.org) If so, what is the USACE involvement?
- 2. Is USACE tracking the offer from Velocity TX to provide a \$60M medical innovation campus between the downtown and BAMC adjacent to its medical-focused, small-business incubator program? Opinion: \$60M pitch for San Antonio research center merits support (expressnews.com) If so, what is the USACE involvement?
- 3. What is the current status of the Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 2024 and major projects authorized in Central and South Texas? The bill, HR 8812, passed the House in June 2024 (BILLS-118hr8812eh.pdf (congress.gov). Water resource projects will be a major topic in the upcoming, biennial, Texas legislative session, especially after the last legislative session established the Texas Water Fund with \$1 billion in state funding (available for state/local entities to pay their non-federal cost share of federal projects). For each of the Central/South Texas studies and new projects please answer the following questions:
- What is the scope of this study/new project?
- Who is the non-federal sponsor?
- Will USACE award a contract or task order for this work? If so, what is the likely acquisition tool, from which USACE organization, and when?
- 4. What is the Districts on IDAC and collaborative delivery methodologies to support your growing infrastructure portfolio?
 - a. Are there specific projects identified in your FY25/26 portfolio that will fall under the IDAC model?
