What is the Hiring our Heroes (HoH) Corporate Fellowship Program (CFP)?



- 12-week fellowship, 4 days/week with host company
- Available to transitioning servicemembers within 180 days of separation and military spouses
- No direct cost to host company
- HoH CFP is a program underneath Department of Defense (DoD) Skillbridge.

Why Should My Business Participate?





- Hiring opportunity with access to competitive talent
- Flexible leaders with federal and geographic experience that consistently perform under pressure
- Opportunity for fellows to receive hands-on industry experience and for host companies to understand the veteran market
- Military experience emphasizes leadership, interpersonal skills, conflict management, and real-world experience

When Are Fellows Available?



- 3 rotating CFP cohorts each year.
- Access to resumes of fellows ~1 month before cohort starts
- HoH sponsors career summits and hiring fairs across the US, in-person and virtual.
- Off-cycle and virtual fellowships are possible but may not be as meaningful





What Should I Expect From a Fellow?

- Diverse talent pool with spectrum of experiences.
- DoD veteran that's fluent in federal language, culture, nuances, and systems.
- The ideal recruit thrives under pressure and quickly adapts with new skills

What Does a Successful Fellowship Look Like?





Timeline	Planned Events
Weeks 1-2	Onboarding, Introduction to industry and organizational leadership
Weeks 3-4	Networking, breadth work within assigned department and position
Weeks 5-6	Networking, breadth work in external departments and exposure to other roles
Weeks 7-8	Networking, interview negotiations, depth work in future position
Weeks 9-10	Depth work and integration to position
Weeks 11-12	Fellowship summary, review, and preparation for employment

What's the Best-Case Scenario?

- Personal Goal: Start a new career in a desired industry, role, and location
- HoH CFP Goal: Civilian employment after military service
- Host Company Goal: Match a vacant position with a talented individual that adds value to the company.

Summarized Transition Timeline

When a Veteran is within 180 days of transition, they qualify for CFP



Veteran applies for CFP Cohort



3 months before cohort, resumes are released to employers



1.5 months before cohort, veterans are matched with an employer



1 month before cohort, reconsideration phase occurs (if needed)

12-week CFP Cohort Begins



If desired, the employer extends a job offer



Cohort ends, veteran returns to military for out-processing



Veteran transitions out of the military



Veteran
becomes a
CFP advocate
and assists
with additional
veteran hires






