LIEUTENANT COLONEL JOHN W. MARSHALL

Lieutenant Colonel John W. Marshall is currently the Commander, 56th Civil Engineer Squadron, Luke Air Force Base, Arizona. As the Base Civil Engineer he commands 370 military and civilian engineers providing engineering expertise and operational support to the 56th Fighter Wing's two F-16 Squadrons and 5 F-35 Squadrons, the 56th Training Squadron, and the 607th Air Control Squadron. His program management responsibilities include an annual budget of \$40M to support operations, maintenance, repair and construction of real property and infrastructure worth \$3.4B, across 5.8M acres, 1,000 buildings, and 500 family housing units. Further, he is responsible for fire protection, environmental protection, explosive ordnance disposal, disaster preparedness and emergency management for Luke AFB.



Lt Col Marshall joined the Air Force in 2006 and was commissioned through the Reserve Officer Training Corp at the University of Portland, in Portland, Oregon after graduating with a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering. Lt Col Marshall is a Senior Air Force Civil Engineer Officer and has served in various Civil Engineer Squadron assignments with experience in design engineering, construction project and portfolio management, asset management, contract oversight, construction programming, civil engineer readiness, energy management and has served in roles at the Installation, Major Command, Combatant Command, and Headquarters Air Force levels. He has deployed 5 times in support of Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, IRAQI FREEDOM, NEW DAWN, RESOLUTE SUPPORT and INHERENT RESOLVE.

LIEUTENANT COLONEL CHRISTOPHER C. JAMES

Lieutenant Colonel Christopher C. James is the Commander, 56th Contracting Squadron, Luke Air Force Base, Arizona. He leads a team of 44 mission-focused military and civilian business leaders in the annual execution of service, supply, construction, and specialized contracts totaling \$91 million in support of the Air Force's Largest Fighter Wing, the 944th Fighter Wing, and the Barry M. Goldwater Range. The squadron also trains and equips mission-ready joint Contingency Contracting Officers for worldwide deployment. Lieutenant Colonel James is a key member of the wing's senior staff and principal business advisor to the Wing Commander.

Lieutenant Colonel James entered active duty in 2009 after commissioning through the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps program at Loyola Marymount University, Los Angeles, California. Shortly after entering the Air Force, he earned a Master of Business Administration degree from National University, La Jolla CA, in 2010. Before entering the Contracting career field in 2014, Lieutenant Colonel James served in the nuclear enterprise. Positions held include: Intercontinental Ballistic Missile Combat Crew Commander, ICBM Combat Crew Instructor, and Assistant Flight Commander.



As a contracting professional, in 2020, Lieutenant Colonel James deployed to Kabul, Afghanistan as the Chief of Contract Integration for the Combined Security Transition Command as a member of NATO forces in support of OPERATION RESOLUTE SUPPORT. He's held an unlimited warrant and served as a Contracting Officer and Contracting Division Chief on orbital and ground based offensive counter space weapon programs as a part of the Space Systems Center, Los Angeles Space Force Base, CA. In addition, Lieutenant Colonel James was the Director of Operations and Chief of Policy for the 502d Contracting Squadron, executing a \$1.1B portfolio in support of 266 mission partners and the largest joint base in the Department of Defense. Prior to his current assignment, he was a graduate student in Air Command and Staff College with a concentration in space strategy as a member of the Schriever Space Scholars. Following graduate studies, his research on the effects of over classification on space weapon system procurements was published by a peer reviewed journal in 2023.

Future City Competition is coming up!

SAME Phoenix Post is once again participating in Arizona's regional Future City Competition, sponsoring an award for Best Demonstration of Teamwork, and we need your support! For those not familiar with the Future City Competition, here's a great summary from their **Website**.

Future City starts with a question—how can we make the world a better place? To answer it, 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students imagine, research, design, and build cities of the future that showcase their solution to a citywide sustainability issue. Past topics include stormwater management, urban agriculture, public spaces, and green energy. The 2024-2025 theme is Above the Current. Teams will design a city and provide two innovative examples of how their floating city works and keeps its citizens healthy and safe.

Participants complete five deliverables: a 1,500-word city essay; a scale model (or multiple model segments) built from recycled materials; a project plan, a presentation video, and a Q&A session with judges. Regional winners represent their region at the international Finals. After completing Future City, student participants are not only prepared to be citizens of today's complex and technical world, but also poised to become the drivers of tomorrow.

As a part of our sponsorship, *SAME Phoenix Post is developing a team of volunteers* to participate in reviewing competition essays as well as in-person judging of the models and presentations that the students have prepared about their models. The competition will follow the schedule below:

- Mid December, 2024 January 11, 2025: List of teams applying for awards available are to be provided. Competition Essays will be made available to sponsors for review on their own time during this month. ~ 2 hrs
- January 11-16, 2025: Models will be available at the Burton Barr Library (Phoenix, AZ) for judging on your own time if your schedule allows. Volunteer input may be used to help narrow down the slate of presentations to be judged on the day of the competition. ~ 2 hrs
- January 18, 2025: Morning attendance at the competition event at Casteel High School in Queen Creek. This is a great chance to see the kids work very hard at their presentations and get really excited to meet people in industry! Opportunity around noon to hand SAME Phoenix award out in person to the winning team with a photo opportunity. ~ 5 hrs

Participating in this event is an incredibly rewarding experience and the kids gain so much from our attention and care to judge their work!
