

# MCAS Yuma "Unique"




- Marine Corps' Premier Aviation Training Facility

#### Major Projects



Project Title	Cost	Scope
B634 Renovation	\$13.9M	Replacement of sewer piping, plumbing fixtures, recapitalization of the facility to include electrical, HVAC units, centralized ducting, and common spaces.
P538 BEQ	\$88.3M	Demolition of 3 existing two-story BEQ facilities and new construction of 1 compound conforming to USMC modernized standards. Parking lot, basketball court and adjacent amenities included.
P595U Water Treatment Plant Upgrades	\$7.8M	Recapitalization of portions existing system, modernization of SCADA package, and installation of UV component.
P591 Water Treatment Plant	Pre-award/Design	Installation of new water treatment plant, replacement of existing water tanks, and demolition of old facility.
P622 BEQ	Pre-award/Design	Installation of new parking garage and 3 story BEQ complex conforming modernized USMC standards.
P635 BEQ	Pre-award/Design	Recapitalization of B635 to conform with modernized USMC standards to include replacement of existing chiller plant.
Annual Recurring BSM1 Budget for Construction	\$10.8M	Various projects ranging in complexity, scope, and quantity







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
